

## EXHIBITION NOTES:

1. The set up day will be Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> November. Works accepted for exhibition should be delivered to the gallery between 10am and 12 noon as set up will take place during the afternoon. Take down will be Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> November.
2. Transport – Artists will be responsible to transport their work to the gallery and to collect unsold work at the end of the exhibition. The Gallery will liaise with purchasers in relation to delivery and installation of sold works.
3. Stone is of course heavy – please ensure that the work submitted is able to be handled by two people.
4. We will be producing a hard copy catalogue and therefore please ensure that your images are high resolution, and give a clear and uncluttered view of your work – last year we sold from the catalogue images so this is very worthwhile. Please also ensure that your images are named with your name and the title of your artwork.
5. Sales – all work must be available to purchase.
6. Prices explained: – The Artist price is the minimum amount that you wish to receive on a sale of your work. The retail price (price to the customer) will be comprised of your artist price plus an equal margin. The Gallery will not be taking any commission on sales and the whole of this margin will be donated to the Masons Company Craft Fund, a registered charity. For example if your Artist price is £500 the retail price would be £1,000 and you would receive your artist price and the charity would also receive £500.
7. Biography – we will include this in the catalogue.
8. Artwork Details – please complete these fully – we need accurate dimensions and descriptions of the medium.
